- G** **Amen.**

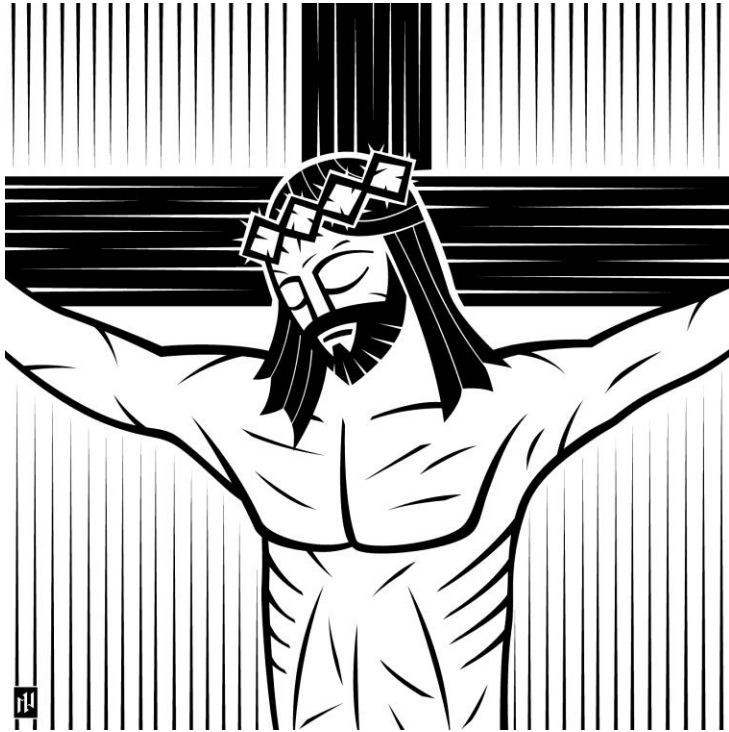
Evening
